#### **Zoning Change Proposal**

The owner of the property at Walton Blvd. and Rochdale Drive has yet again petitioned to have his property changed from residential to commercial. By law he can petition yearly until it comes before the city council, which has not yet happened. Interested parties will be notified before such a meeting and are encouraged to attend. In the past, many Rochdale residents have expressed their opposition to any proposed change to the present zoning. With ever-increasing congestion and traffic, the residential nature of our neighborhood needs to be preserved Any calls or letters to the Rochester Hills Planning Commission will be noted and presented at a future hearing.
